CALL TO ORDER: Chairman Hawkins called the meeting to order at 5:33 p.m.

New Business:

1. State Transportation Improvement Program – Tom Queen, Georgia Department of Transportation.

Mr. Queen distributed the *Preconstruction Status Report for District: Jones* to the commissioners and a *State Transportation Improvement Program Rural Draft* report for Jones County's Sidewalks and Bike Trails in Gray. They discussed each project and related time tables.

New legislation signed by the Governor creating new processes, committees and boards were discussed. The Board of Commissioners asked questions and discussed the Round Table representatives and processes at length. Included in the presentation were the new project criteria, new distribution of motor fuel tax, and the Executive Committee composition with five members from each region. Funding for projects and the required county's matching contributions being either 10%, 30% or 50% will be determined, in part, by approval criteria

from the county voters and the round table. New legislation for Transit Coordination (Jones County's 5311 program) will provide improvements resulting in more efficient operations and management.
