State Representative Bubber Epps, members of the Board of Education, School Superintendent Billy Mathews, City Council and Mayor from the City of Gray, City Superintendent Decius Aaron, County Administrator Mike Underwood and County Clerk Leila Brittain also attended. Commissioner Larry Childs was unable to attend due to a family illness in Atlanta.

**Call to Order:** **Doug Redmond, Executive Director of the Jones County Development Authority called the meeting to order at 5:02 p.m.**

Each governing authority gave a brief overview of their 2011 budgets, current projects underway as well as future plans for capital projects such as future school construction/renovations and expansion of the City's wastewater treatment plant. Each of the governing authorities asked questions and were given the opportunity to discuss interrelated issues such as water rates for the school system and the repairs currently being made on Davis Road by the county. With an estimated completion date prior to the beginning of the new school year, the Davis Road project should assist with traffic flow for the new Turnerwoods Elementary School.

State Representative Bubber Epps recognized Mr. Chap Nelson attending the meeting who is running unopposed in the November 2, 2010 Special Election for the District Two County Commissioner seat. Rep. Epps then gave a report on governmental issues at the state level. A wide range of topics were discussed including budgets and changes to the Transportation Department.

The City and County discussed rescheduling their Service Delivery Strategy Meeting. Members of the audience were given the opportunity to address local officials.
