

RESOLUTION
JONES COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS
SENIOR CENTER CDBG APPLICATION

WHEREAS, the Georgia Department of Community Affairs has established the Community Development Block Grant program to assist cities and counties with improvements to public facilities, economic development, and housing in Georgia, and

WHEREAS, there exists in Jones County a need for a new expanded and improved Senior Center.

WHEREAS, the proposed improvements will cost approximately \$500,000 in CDBG funds to contract,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Jones County Board of Commissioners that Jones County supports the application for CDBG funds and that Jones County will apply for these funds to build a new Senior Center and Jones County also commits to \$52,600 in local funding.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Jones County shall be responsible for operation and maintenance of the Senior Center, if funded.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that J. Preston Hawkins, Chairman is authorized and directed to act as the official representative of Jones County to act in connection with the application and to be responsible for the compliance with the applicable state and federal requirements of the program and to provide such additional information as may be required.


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that J. Preston Hawkins, Chairman is authorized to enter into agreements for grant administration and engineering services relating to the application and subsequent grant (if funded) and to execute the application and other required documents on behalf of Jones County.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a true and dedicated commitment has been made to the project for the successful completion of the above improvements for the citizens, especially the County's low to moderate income citizens.
