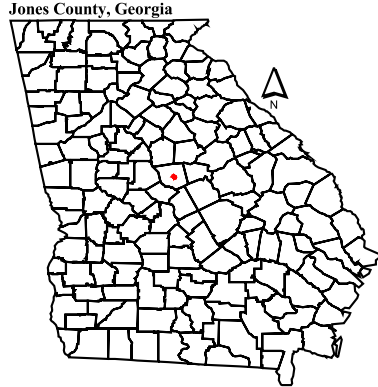
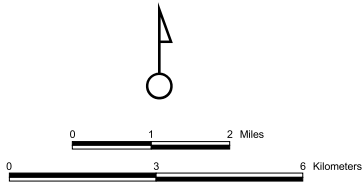
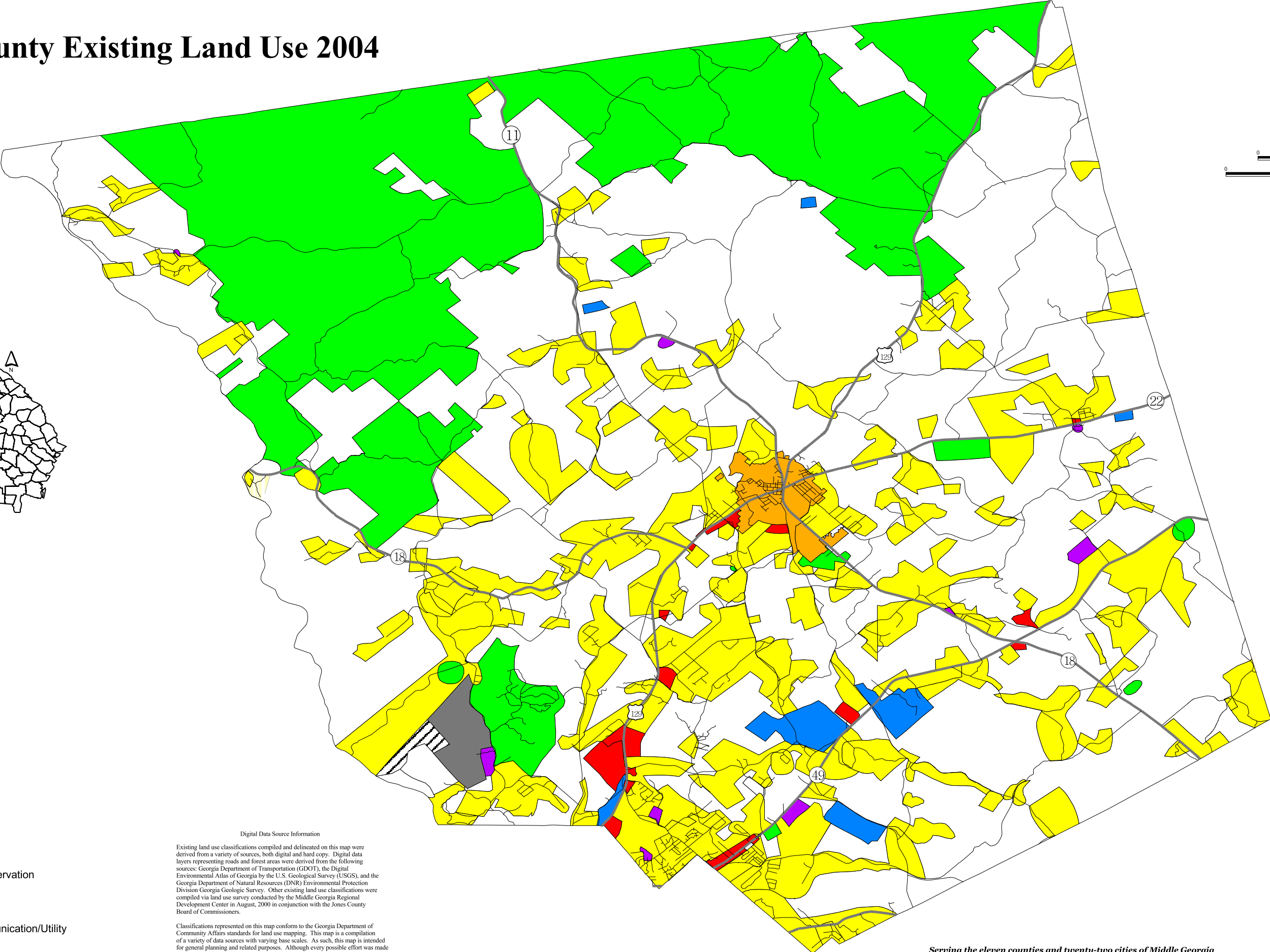


Jones County Existing Land Use 2004

Digital Data Source Information

Existing land use classifications compiled and delineated on this map were derived from a variety of sources, both digital and hand copy. Digital data layers representing roads and forest areas were derived from the following sources: Georgia Department of Transportation (GDOT), the Digital Environmental Atlas of Georgia by the U.S. Geological Survey (USGS), and the Georgia Department of Natural Resources (DNR) Environmental Protection Division Georgia Geologic Survey. Other existing land use classifications were compiled via land use survey conducted by the Middle Georgia Regional Development Center in August, 2000 in conjunction with the Jones County Board of Commissioners.

Classifications represented on this map conform to the Georgia Department of Community Affairs standards for land use mapping. This map is a compilation of a variety of data sources with varying base scales. As such, this map is intended for general planning and related purposes. Although every possible effort was made to create this map with the highest degree of accuracy, the Middle Georgia RDC and the Jones County Board of Commissioners assume no responsibility for the legal accuracy of the information represented on this map.
