The Jones County Board of Commissioners met for a Work Session at 4:30 p.m. on February 18, 2020 at the Knox Civic Center. Members present were:

Chairman Weidner called the work session to order at 4:30 p.m.

APPROVAL OF THE AGENDA:

The Board of Commissioners met to discuss holiday pay, comp time, flextime, and over time. Matt Goins, Parks, Rec and Golf Director opened the meeting by telling the Board the main concerns he had about holiday pay and comp time. He asked the Board to please consider allowing the 8 hour holiday to count towards the 40 hour work week. Will Harp, IT Director, told the Board he did not like the idea of flextime and wanted to continue to accumulate comp time. Jennifer Allen, Animal Services Director, asked the Board to consider call out pay for supervisors. Chuck Conger, Public Works employee, stated that being compensated was incentive to do his job. Marion Hatton, Elections Superintendent, stated she liked comp time. LaVita Crutchfield and April Purser, Finance Department, spoke about timesheets being done incorrectly and the amount of errors that one department has every payroll. They also went over policies pertaining to overtime and comp time. Angie Frazier, Convenience Center Supervisor, stated she turns payroll in on time and, for all the years she has worked here, no one trained her.

Comm. Martin stated that there was no one policy that would fit all or make all happy, but the Board needed to look for the greater good. He stated that employees do not need to lose time. He asked for the employees to look over the sample policies and that another work session was needed for further discussion.

Comm. Kitchens suggested changing the schedule at Public Works to make sure all days were covered and John Lowe stated he would need to talk to his guys first.
