The Jones County Board of Commissioners called for a Work Session at 3:30 p.m. on August 21, 2019 in the Charlotte C. Wilson Conference Room at the Jones County Government Center. Members present were:

Chairman Weidner called the work session to order at 3:31 p.m.

APPROVAL OF THE AGENDA: Chairman Weidner asked for approval of the agenda. Comm. Robinson made the motion to approve. Comm. Kitchens seconded. Vote – unanimous.

Donald White, Assistant Building Maintenance Supervisor, spoke about renting a bucket truck instead of buying one. He also talked about many projects that needed to be done around the county. The courthouse exterior, the government center exterior side walls, the government center drain issues, and an air conditioner unit for station 5 fire department. Mr. White also requested an employee slot to be added to his department.

Jennifer Allen, Animal Services Director, stated that a backup generator is needed at the shelter in order to keep the water running for the animals during an emergency. She also stated the shelter needed cameras for safety concerns and an F150 to replace the truck that has had transmission problems.

Anthony George, Chief Tax Assessor, requested new ceiling tiles for his office.

Charles Cook, Safety Officer, requested additional cameras to monitor the new walking track and dog park at the Government Center and the shop area at Public Works.

John Lowe, Public Works Director, requested new floors for the office area, the outside of the building to be painted, power units for the trash compactors, spraying for the dirt roads and restriping of Jarrell Plantation intersection.

Pam Dixon, Superior Court Clerk, requested a permanent line item for upgrades to be made at the courthouse. The audio visual system and the tables in the courtroom need to be upgraded.

Matt Jarrett, Coroner, requested an additional deputy coroner position.

ADJOURNMENT: Comm. Robinson made the motion to adjourn. Comm. Martin seconded. Vote – unanimous. The meeting adjourned at 5:12 p.m.
